

We are leading Orlando Summer Project (OSP) 2008!



During OSP 2006, we were on the staff member team leading 30 summer interns. That summer we mentored 7 students, lead the evangelism and prayer teams and saw God move powerfully.

This summer I am honored to accept the position of **associate director/women's director**. Marc will also be on the team. This is an amazing

opportunity to be a part of developing Godly leaders. We have already seen many students from OSP 2006 go into some type of ministry.

As a director I am excited and awed to start planning the project. Marc went on OSP in 2001. It was a major part of our decision to become missionaries, so we know first hand what a life changing experience it can be.

Would you please join in us in praying:

- God will call students to come.
After Christmas, thousands of college students will go to Campus Crusade Christmas conferences. Those students will be challenged to go on a summer project. Many of 2008's OSP students will decide to come in the next 1-2 months and I will evaluate their applications.
- God will provide housing for the students.
OSP students usually live in condos in Ventura. The condos are expensive, far away from headquarters and we have had trouble with the mangement in the past (not because of the students). I am asking God to provide another place, preferably closer and cheaper.

Before the project, our staff team will spend a week together. This week is critical as the team begins building relationships (most staff members won't know each other) and plan for the project ahead. Above all, please pray God would use OSP to develop leaders who will carry the Great Commission forward wherever life takes them.

Testing for the problem

Evangeline will have gall bladder surgery soon.

Over the last two months Evangeline has had abdominal pain that keeps her awake at night and makes it difficult to eat. She has lost 20 pounds and has been getting infections.

Two years ago, we went to the doctor for similar pain (not as bad), but he was unable to find the cause.

We are grateful the doctor was able to discover that Evangeline has low gall bladder function (no stones). We will set the surgery date after she meets with her surgeon, but her doctor hopes to have the surgery done in the next week.
